### General Notices

#### **Arrangements in school to commemorate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the armistice in World War 1 (PEW)**

The commemoration consists of two separate activities. Inevitably activities to mark this historic anniversary will cause disruption to lessons in general and PE in particular but I know we all understand the importance of ensuring our students (and indeed staff) are given the opportunity to contemplate World War One, to reflect on its horrors and the lessons we can learn from it in 2018, during a period of world-wide 'Remembrance' events culminating on 11<sup>th</sup> November. The first activity is an assembly to each year group Year 7 to 13, by students from Year 7 to 13, about World War One on the theme of 'Remembrance'.

#### **ASSEMBLIES** in the Hall:

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> November:

P1 – Y9 (Pe X Half, Geog Y Half) Students go straight from Tutor Time to the Hall and line up in Tutor Groups as if for an assembly. Period 1 teaching staff to join them promptly.

P2 – Y7 (Pe X Half, second half of double tech Y Half). Students go straight from P1 lesson to the Hall and line up in Tutor Groups as if for an assembly. Period 2 teaching staff join them promptly.

P3 – Y10 (Option Block) Students go straight from break to the Hall and line up in Tutor Groups as if for an assembly. Period 3 teaching staff join them promptly.

P4 – Y8 (Pe X Half, History / Computing Y Half) Students go straight from P3 lesson to the Hall and line up in Tutor Groups as if for an assembly. Period 4 teaching staff join them promptly.

P5 - Y11 (Option Block) Students go straight from lunchtime to the Hall and line up in Tutor Groups as if for an assembly. Period 5 teaching staff join them promptly.

Students need to line up in alphabetical order outside the Hall as if for a normal assembly. Bags are taken into the Hall as usual. Students will leave the Hall via the PE corridor.

Monday 12<sup>th</sup> November:

P1- Year 12/13 together

Students go straight from Tutor Time to the Hall and line up in Tutor Groups as if for an assembly. Period 1 teaching staff to join them promptly.

#### **WHOLE-SCHOOL SERVICE**


