Songwriting Workshop (RBR)

On Tuesday 27th November, we have an education specialist from Steinberg Media Technologies coming to the music department to run a Songwriting Workshop using the Cubase music software. We have recently updated our software to the latest industry specifications and with the new version comes many features that composers and producers use as standard when creating music. The workshop will allow students to explore the 'chord track' which enables the composer to work with harmony in a more advanced and creative way. The two sessions will last for two periods each and take place in Ex5.
