Year 9 Uniform

A reminder that from Monday 25th February all Year 9 girls are expected to be in the new plaid school skirt, or suitable school trousers.

From this date the school grey skirt must not be worn. The plaid skirt must not be altered in any way and should cover the knee at all times.

If female students choose to wear mid-grey school trousers it is essential that they adhere to the school dress code:-

The school dress code states that trousers for males and females should be of a certain type:

- They should be properly tailored and should not be considered a fashion trouser.
- The following trousers are not acceptable: hipster cut, made of lycra, combat style, jeans style, treggins, jeggins, skinny, drainpipe or baggy.
- Trouser hems should be properly tailored, should not be frayed nor should the hem drag on the floor.
- No studded or fashion belts are permitted, belts should be black with a small buckle.
- Black or grey socks which cover the ankle must be worn, trainer socks are not acceptable.

All trousers must fall free from the leg from the thigh to the shoe.

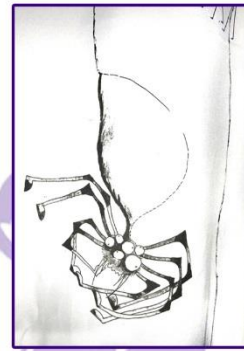
