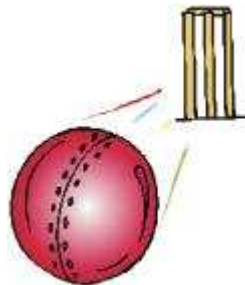

Brain Teaser

Some numbers are happy and others are not!

To find out whether a number is happy square each of its digits, add the answers and repeat. If you end up with 1 the number is happy!

E.g. Consider 19

$$1^2 + 9^2 = 82$$

$$8^2 + 2^2 = 68$$

$$6^2 + 8^2 = 100$$

$$1^2 + 0^2 + 0^2 = 1 \text{ which means that 19 is a happy number.}$$
