Twilight Language Programme

Come and learn a new language after school this year! French, Italian, Japanese, Mandarin or Spanish

**Enrolment evenings:** Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> September - 3.30p.m. - 5.00p.m. Come along to meet the tutors and discuss the course.

**Classes start:** Week beginning Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September and run until June. Cost: £10 adults, £5 OAPs, Under 18s no charge - (Maximum group size of 30).

**Highcliffe Rec facilities (Mrs Stone):** I have been working with Christchurch Council and the Dorset Youth Service on a project to improve the facilities for young people in Highcliffe. We have managed to obtain £55,000 of funding. Residents and users of Highcliffe Recreation ground are now being asked to choose between two designs for the new play facility which is due to be built there during the winter months so it is ready for next Spring.

Design 1 comprises an aerial cableway, an overhead rotator, a climbing zone, a trim trail, a ball court and a shelter. This design has perimeter fencing and links with the existing play area via a footpath, and mounding. Design 2 comprises an aerial cableway, a single point swing, a climbing rock, an overhead rotator, a Dutch disc, a ball court and a shelter, as well picnic tables, seating and litter bins. There would be no perimeter fencing for this option.

The two plans will be available on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> September from 4.00pm - 7.00pm in the pavilion on the recreation ground so do go along and see them. You will then be invited to vote for your favourite and the plan with the highest number of votes will be the one that is built.
