Four young people will win the opportunity to gain a fantastic insight into how the Police Force is run by shadowing a senior police officer for the day on Friday, 6th November.


Four winners will be offered the chance of taking over Dorset Police, with one winner from each of the following age groups: 10-11 /12-13 /14-15 /16-17 years old.
