Southampton to Shanghai in 40 Days- in Support of the Alzheimer's Society: On 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2011, 3 ex-Highcliffe students, 2009-2010 Head Boy Southampton Samuel Joynson, 2010 Top-A Level Achiever Adam Sloper, and aspiring film director Michael L Worrall, will be embarking on a charity expedition across Eurasia in aid of the Alzheimer's Society. After each experiencing a close relative's decline with the disease in recent years, they decided that they would take part in a project that would raise awareness of the disease, especially among young people, and would raise money for the Alzheimer's Society charity.

Such a project, originating from an idea in a Year 11 Highcliffe School Philosophy and Ethics lesson, has taken the form of an entirely self-organised and self-funded overland charity expedition from Southampton to Shanghai, which they have challenged themselves to complete in just 40 days.


