Literacy Focus -

Here's a useful spelling pattern that, if you learn, can help you with a number of spellings. How do you spell the plural of these words: monkey, key, donkey, play, ploy? How do you spell the plural of these words: try, country, enemy, fly, cry? For the first set of words, you simply add an "s". For the second set of words, you "change the Y to an I and add -es".

Question: Can you spot the pattern?

Answer: Words with a vowel before the final Y add an S. Words with a consonant before the final Y change the Y to an I and add ES.
