Literacy Focus -

How do you spelling the plural of "country", "nationality" and "cry"? Change the "Y" to an "I" and add "es". When you spell the plural of "donkey", "play" or bay", you just add an "S". Why the difference? Answer: The spelling rule is: Consonant + y = change the "Y" to an "I" and add "es". Vowel + y, just add an "S".

If you remember and apply this spelling rule - which I don't think has *any* exceptions - you'll be able to deal with a very common spelling error.
