WE WILL ROCK YOU REHEARSALS


Rehearsals have started again for the school production of We Will Rock You!

MUSIC CLUBS




Guitar Club - Tuesday lunchtime @ 1.30pm in Ex2. This is for all guitarists at any level. If you can play a chord or more come along!
