Ballard/Highcliffe Lecture Series (VDN)

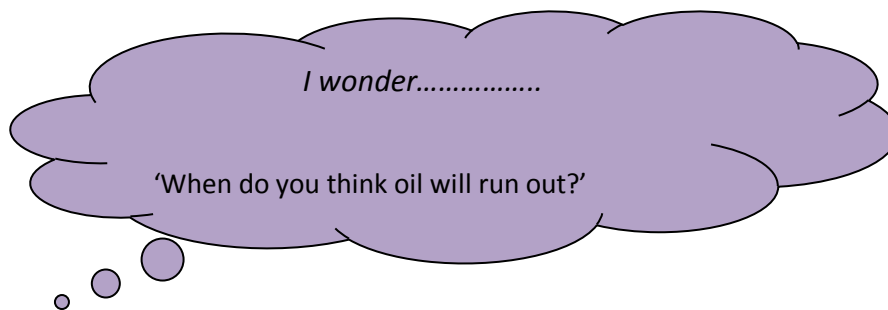
