Ecoclub (RCN)

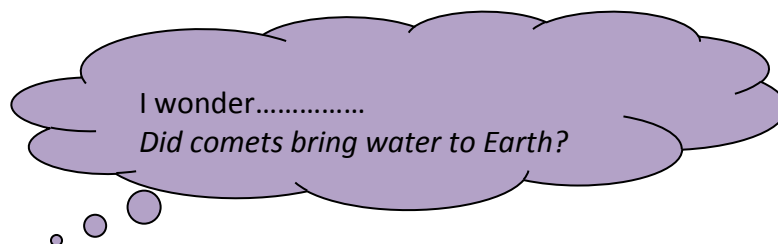
