What are you reading at the moment? Have you got your book for your year group's DEAR-day? It's been great seeing the student receptionists with a book to hand! Have you got yours?

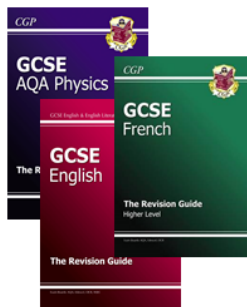

All entries to Mrs Boothroyd by 23rd May.

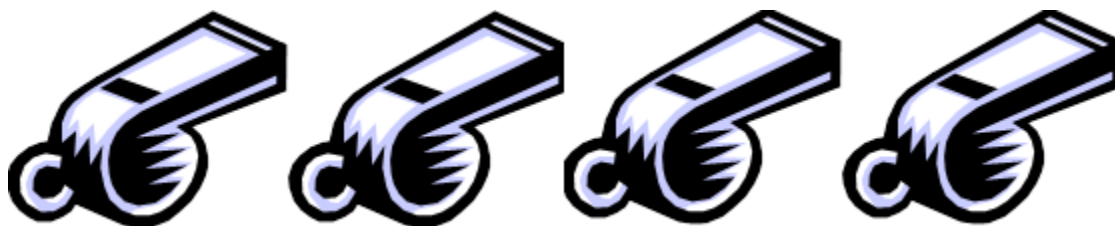
