You can access the programme from the school's online resources area. Click on the 'Use Launchpad' button and go to the section that asks you to type in the licence code. Type in 'tipsinfo69' and this will then let you create a user account. Once this has been done you will have access to a range of activities and information about option choices and there is also a useful action plan section that you can store all your research and information.
