
Words with silent or unclear letters: A Way to Remember: Use the spelling of the root word. Sound out clearly. The government runs the country. Councils govern the local area.

Polli:Nation


Year sevens needed to help encourage pollinators in our local environment!

Having submitted a joint application as a school 'cluster' back in October 2015, we have been selected out of 260 schools across the UK that applied to participate in this unique programme. Over a period of three years, we will now be supported by a Polli:Nation facilitator from Learning through Landscapes- the national school grounds charity responsible for the project. Linking to the National Pollinator Strategy our school will now explore how we might:

- 1. Grow more flowers, shrubs & trees
- 2. Let it grow wild
- 3. Cut grass less often
- 4. Don't disturb insect nests and hibernation spots
- 5. Think carefully about whether to use pesticides

We will be recruiting teams of lower school students to work closely with other local schools and help develop a pollinator friendly environment!

SPORTS UPDATE FEBRUARY 2016

<u>Rugby</u>

Lots of fixtures for all years have taken place since September 2016. The sports tour for Years 9 & 10 took place with good results for rugby and girls football.

Football

The year 7 Football team have shown plenty of potential this season in their matches against Arnewood and St Peters, winning and drawing respectively.

The year 8 Football team's adventure in the Dorset County Cup eventually came to an end losing to Poole High at the quarter final stage. They have played two games so far in the Bournemouth and District league beating Arnewood and losing to St Peters.

The year 9 boys Football have made it through to both the County Cup semi-finals and Bournemouth and District semi-finals. In the County Cup they have beaten Corfe Hills (3-2), BCS (9-1), and Shaftesbury (6-3). With 1 game left to play the boys have secured a place in the semi's having won all their matches against Arnewood (5-3), Twynham (6-1), St Peters (5-1) and BCS (9-1), with only The Grange left to play. Good luck next half term when every match will prove vital if they are to lift any silverware this season.

The year 10 Football team have won both of their Bournemouth league fixtures to date, beating Arnewood and St Peters. This has given them a great opportunity to qualify for the semi-finals. While the year 11 Football team have had a unpredictable season losing to St Peters and drawing with Arnewood.

Cross-country

A small number of students have competed in 3 local cross0country competitions. This is the first year that we have entered these competitions.

At the competition Sandbanks Alexandra Palotai-Avella (Year 7) came 3^{rd.} Scott Riddy (Year 7) came 6^{th.}

At the Canford Race_Alexandra Palotai-Avella (Year 7) came 1^{st,} Mia Elmore (Year 7) came 3rd, Scott Riddy (Year 7) came 6th and Connor Stain (Year 7) came 10th

Results from Ferndown have not been released yet.

Alexandra Palotai-Avella came 6th in the Dorset Cross-country championships so she will be representing the school in the next round.

<u>Netball</u>

The Year 7 Netball team are undefeated so far in the area league. They have beaten Twynham, Avonbourne and BSG. They came 4th in the Area Tournament out of 6 schools.

The Year 8 Netball team have had mixed results in the area league. They have won drawn and lost matches. They came 5th in the Area Tournament out of 10 schools.
