
Clubs and Revision Sessions



Spelling Focus: Closing the Gap

Here are three words that are commonly misspelled:

environment

government

opportunity

Questions:

- 1. Where are these words Danger Zones?
- 2. What strategies would you use to remember the spellings? (There is a different strategy for each spelling.)

Here are some options:

- Learn a rule.
- Find the root word and build from that
- Make a silly sentence or use some other trick to help you remember.
- Sound it out
- Word within a word

Answers:

1. The Danger Zones for the above words are:

environment (sometimes the "n" is missed out) government (sometimes the "n" is missed out) opportunity (sometimes a "p" is missed out and the "or" part is misspelled.)

2. Here are some strategies:

environment – Look at the root word: **environ**ment

This is not a very well-known word so you might be better off **sounding it out** in an exaggerated way: En-vi-ron-ment

Or look for the word within the word: **Ron** loves the envi**ron**ment.


Government – Look at the root word: **govern**ment.

We can all spell "govern". Well, **govern**ment still keeps the "n".
