- 1. The Danger Zones for the above words are:
 - Parliament (We forget the "I")
 - Democracy (We misspell it when we make it plural)
- 2. Here is a strategy for these words:

Parliament:

Find words in the word.

ParlI+Ament Parliament has I AM inside it.

Democracy

We need to remember the rule for this:

Consonant before "Y" at the end of the word changes to "ies" in the plural. This is the same as:

Try – tries

Fly - flies

Nationality - nationalities
