

The Best Words. In the Best Place.

This week's "Word of the Week" is ...

assumption

What are you doing to improve your vocabulary?

What does "assumption" mean? Does is mean ...?

1/ What you have when you add to things together

2/ A kind of pump

3/ Something that is accepted as true without evidence or checking

Answer:

The answer is 3. It is a noun.

Examples:

Don't make an assumption that the answer is correct. Check it!

Don't **assume** your punctuation is correct. Check it!

Critical Thinking:

Think of a time you made an assumption - and you were wrong. Why did you make the assumption? What happened as a result?

Commendation Opportunities:

"Assumption" is not a particularly difficult word – but do you use it? That's your challenge.

Try and use this word in class in writing or in speech. You might get commended for an effective use of it! Break-through commendation: If you use it incorrectly first time, but try again, you might receive a break-through commendation!
